GoCary invites everyone to make the most of this holiday season by exploring the lights, sights, and celebrations of downtown Cary — all while riding fare-free!

Downtown Cary is especially vibrant this time of year thanks to the [Heart of the Holidays](#) celebration, which features twinkling lights, family-friendly activities, festive competitions, and memorable seasonal experiences.

The GoCary [Downtown Loop](#) is adding a special "light-seeing" service on Tuesday evenings from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM, beginning Tuesday, December 2, and continuing through Tuesday, December 23.

This free service is open to the public with no reservations required. Just hop on at any of the 13 [Downtown Loop](#) stops throughout downtown Cary to experience the holiday lights, decorations, and seasonal activities.

The [Downtown Loop](#) will follow its regular route, running continuously from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM. Free parking is available at Town Hall, with a bus stop conveniently located just outside of the parking deck. Riders can look forward to a bus decorated for the season with festive music and fun holiday-themed giveaways.

If you aren't able to join us on a Tuesday night, the Downtown Loop will also continue to operate on its regular schedule, Thursday-Sunday, during this time.

GoCary will not operate on Thursday, November 27, in observance of the Thanksgiving holiday.

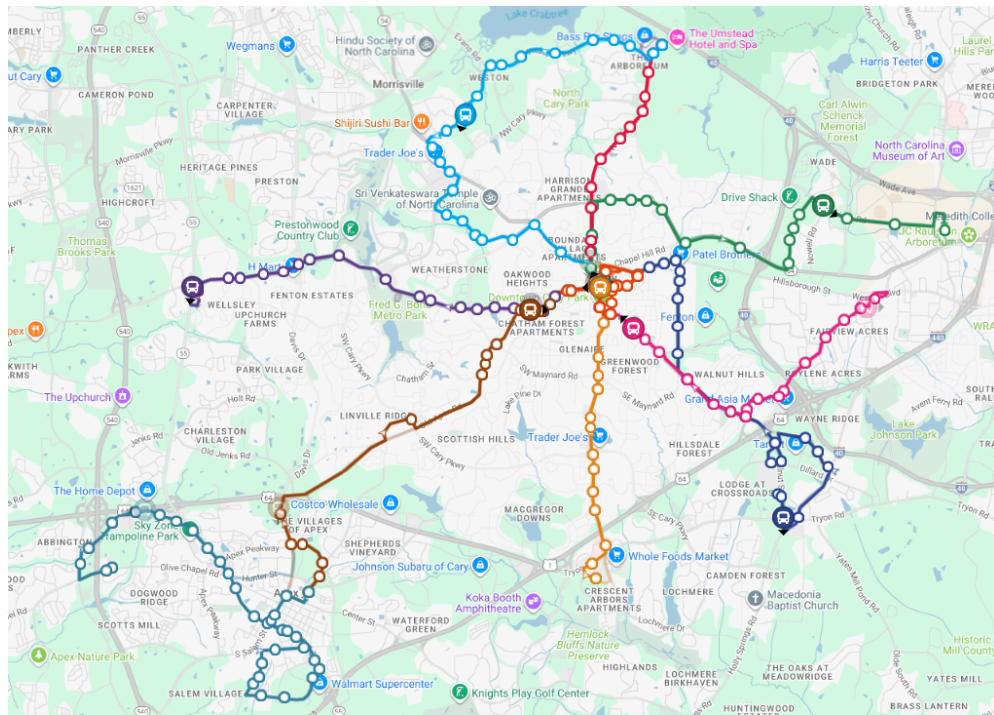
Regular service will resume on Friday, November 28.

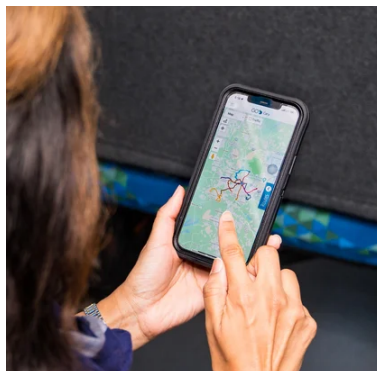
[Track Your Bus Live >](#)
